Students:

The Drama & Theatre department has over 70 students studying A Level Drama & Theatre.

Staff:

The successful candidate will become the second teacher in the department alongside a Head of Department. They are also supported by a full-time technician.

Courses & Exam Board: A Level Drama & Theatre (AQA)

Department/Facilities:

The Drama and Theatre department staff share an office with the other performance based subject staff. In terms of facilities, we have a Drama Studio complete with costume storage facilities, lighting rigs and sound system. The College Theatre is a performance space with a modern sprung floor. Shows for Drama & Theatre tend to take place in the Studio. The College Theatre is split in to two sections and can be constructed to become one large space for use on some occasions for shows and performances.

Additional Information:

The successful candidate will have a thorough understanding of Drama & Theatre as a discipline and an innovative and enthusiastic approach to teaching. They need to be willing to contribute to A level Drama & Theatre. The College is strongly committed to offering performance opportunities outside of the curriculum, with a wide range of productions and other activities regularly taking place. In addition to our successful A level courses, the Drama & Theatre department is responsible for delivery of the College Production, leading to a show in the second term and Theatre Workshop is also offered as an extension course. We offer a wide range of enrichment opportunities, such as targeted support for applicants to RADA and LAMDA, workshops and theatre/dance show trips to enable students to build analysis techniques in preparation for their examinations and to broaden their understanding of performance construction and professional techniques. A high proportion of our students progress to drama, dance or performance related degrees or drama school.

College teaching periods start at 8.55am and end at 4.15pm. Each teaching period is 65 minutes.
