Students:

Physical Education is a popular subject with approximately 250 students currently taking A Level PE or BTEC Sport (Level 3). A further 25 students take Sports Leadership Awards.

Staff:

There are 6 members of teaching staff, supported by a technician. The department also employs 5 peripatetic sports coaches to run sports teams on a Wednesday afternoon.

Courses & Exam Board:

The College offers both A Level PE and BTEC Sports Coaching and Development (Level 3), following the OCR and Pearson specification respectively. The department also offers the Community Sports Leaders Award and Higher Sports Leader Award to students across the College.

Department/Facilities:

This is an exciting opportunity to join the PE team. The department is fully resourced and boasts excellent sports facilities including a 3G pitch, modern sports hall as well as a fitness suite which is staffed by a Level 3 fitness instructor. Teaching and learning is supported by regular trips and visits.

Additional information:

As a sixth form college, we are strongly committed to enriching the wider curriculum by offering PE and sporting opportunities for all. Therefore, in addition to the work within the examined curriculum, the members of the department make significant contributions to the Extension Studies programme, College teams and sporting activities for leisure interest. The College has some excellent sporting achievements to its credit in recent years across a range of sports, including Football, Rugby, Basketball, Hockey and Netball. In addition, a number of individuals have achieved county, regional and national honours in a range of individual sports. This includes some outstanding individual performances in the recent Association of Colleges regional championships. The department also pro-actively celebrates gifted and talented sports students within their Roll of Sporting Excellent (ROSE) initiative. The department is affiliated with several external clubs/associations that provide enrichment opportunities far and wide: for example, Knights basketball club.
