TEACHER OF ART – 4 DAYS PER WEEK

Students:

The Art and Design Department at Esher offers both A Level Fine Art and the BTEC National Certificate and Diploma in Art and Design. All are popular courses with around 100 students studying A level Fine Art and over 70 students studying on one of the BTEC courses. Results are very good, reflecting the ambitious and forward-looking approach of the department.

Staff:

The current departmental team consists of the Head of Department and four part time teachers (including the course leader for A level Fine Art). All are experienced, specialist teachers of Art and Design. The teachers are supported by one full time and one part time technician, who are integral to the team. In the team we very much work with a collaborative ethos, to enrich the student experience, as well as being an opportunity for all staff to learn and develop as practitioners too.

Courses & Exam Board:

The department teaches the OCR syllabus for A Level Fine Art and Pearson syllabus for both BTEC courses.

Department/Facilities:

Teaching for A Level Fine Art takes place in bespoke and well equipped, spacious classrooms. Teaching materials are shared on the department's portal site and learning is supported with regular trips and visits. There is also a small print room in the department, and students benefit from technician support with laser cutting and a shared 3D workshop. All students have access to extensive IT facilities across the college.
