

FURTHER INFORMATION MUSIC TECHNICIAN

The Post:

The technician will be an integral part of the dynamic Music Department team of staff, and will be required to support the staff and students in BTEC Music Technology, A Level Music and BTEC Performing Arts lessons. The role involves maintaining, setting up and demonstrating equipment in the recording studio, as well as working with individuals or small groups of students providing technical support. The successful candidate would have the flexibility to help in any area of the Division if required. In general, the College wishes to regard all staff as part of a larger team working together to achieve the general aim of providing high quality education.

Hours:

This is a full-time, term time only post, 36 hours per week for 39 weeks per year.

Salary:

The actual salary will be £20, 999 per annum inclusive of fringe area allowance.

College Year:

The College year runs for a period of twelve months from 1^{st} September -31^{st} August, with the Autumn term often starting in the last week of August. Term time is 39 weeks. Working hours would be 36 hours per week, 8.45 am to 5.00 pm (Mon-Thurs) and 8.45 am to 4.45 pm (Fri) excluding lunch breaks.
