Staff:

The Psychology departmental team consists of the Head of Department, three full-time and five part-time teachers. All are experienced specialist teachers of Psychology.

Department/Facilities:

The majority of teaching takes place in specialist classrooms, with teaching materials shared on departmental portal sites and booklets for students. Learning is supported with occasional trips and talks by guest speakers.
