Students:

Geography is a popular subject with around 250 students currently studying A level Geography at Esher College. Results are very good and the department is forward looking, using a variety of teaching and learning techniques to deliver its courses.

Staff:

The current departmental team consists of the Head of Department, two full time teachers, one part-time teacher and an Assistant Principal. All are experienced specialist teachers of Geography.

Courses & Exam Board:

The department teaches the Pearson Edexcel specification.

Department/Facilities:

Teaching takes place in two specialist classrooms located adjacent to a departmental office. The department has access to (and regular timetabled use of) another classroom equipped with a full class set of computers, as well as access to a class set of laptops which can be booked in advance of the lesson. Teaching materials are shared on the department's portal site and learning is supported with regular trips and visits. The department makes a wider contribution to the college's Extension Studies programme including the delivery of a Geographical Information System (GIS) course.
